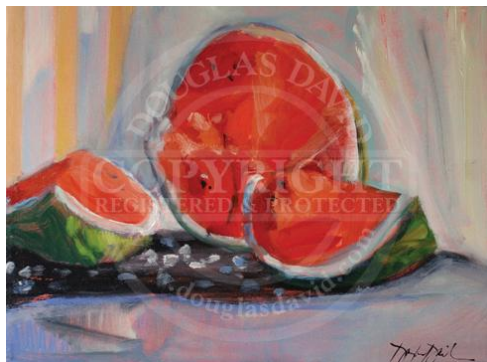

### **Class Description:**

Douglas delivers sound principles of painting that are an incredible foundation for your work, whether you are a beginner or a seasoned professional.

The class will cover the basic principles of oil in regard to painting florals and still lifes. The focus for this 3-day workshop will be dynamic compositions with arrangements that are elegant and sophisticated, casual and relaxed, all while keeping a bold direction. It'll include interesting and memorable discussions on composition, massing, building form, light and shadow, and depending on your style, knowing when a piece is finished, and learning to not overwork your painting.



After the morning intro, Douglas will overview his palette and the concepts in his works. Students will mix paints and learn to fuse basic strings of color to simplify the painting process and help them understand values. Students will work from photos provided by Douglas that include Lilacs, Peonies, Hydrangea florals, and something like watermelon or citrus still lifes. Fresh cut Lilacs, Peonies, and Hydrangeas will be used if they are in bloom. Students will work in their style/technique so that the finished work is their own. Demos and individual discussions/instruction will help each student reach the preliminary goals they are striving to meet, and pieces can be as simple or as complicated as desired.

Several paintings will be produced in the 3-day workshop. Enjoy some great stories that will help you remember the foundational principles of Douglas' teaching.

### **Douglas David's Biography**

Douglas David has painted his way across the country, capturing the beauty and spirit of the things he loves—tranquil country landscapes, sunrises, and sunsets on his favorite beaches, a simple pitcher of spring lilacs or peonies, a slice of watermelon on a checkered tablecloth. His paintings are beautiful, simple, and timeless. After graduating with honors from Herron School of Art, Indiana University, Douglas went on to study for several years with Frank Mason, famed instructor from the Art Students League of New York and student of Frank Vincent DuMond. A recipient of numerous regional and national awards and honors, Douglas is a member of many art

associations and clubs including Hoosier Art Salon, Naples Art Association, Palette & Chisel Academy of Fine Arts, Salmagundi Club, and Southern Vermont Arts Center. Douglas's teaching is a way of giving back and sharing some of his journey with those who choose to study with him. He loves to share insights into the DuMond Palette with his students and bases his teachings on classic principles.

Douglas's work has been chosen for many private and public collections, including the Vice President's residence, the United States Embassy to Sierra Leone, and most recently, by request of Ambassador Donnelly, the United States Embassy to the Holy See (Vatican City). 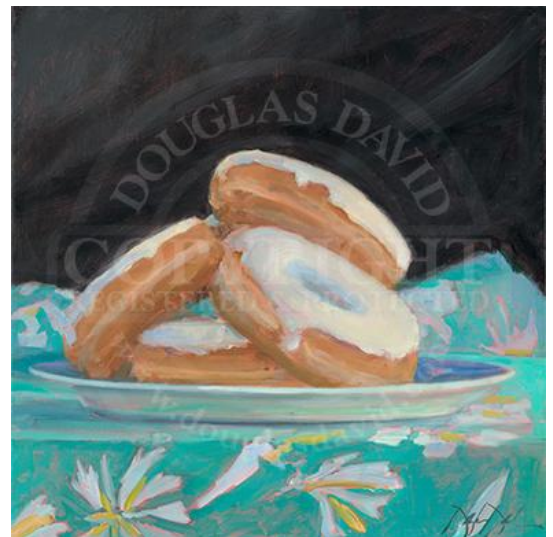

A tabletop or floor easel, apron, notebook or sketchbook, and pencil, are recommended.

\*Hoosier Art Salon has a limited quantity of easels upon request.

And anything else a student needs to help them paint well and feel comfortable.

You can prime all canvas with a thin coat of thinned down Cad Red light and Titanium White Acrylic to make a pink or light red salmon tone on canvas. It can be thin and applied with a blue shop towel or rag. It can also be done in class if that is easier. (You can paint oil over acrylic but can't paint acrylic over oil.) Douglas has a "suitcase of supplies" he brings along, it includes some recommended books, and some supplies in case students need a few items that are forgotten (limited quantities).

### Class Tentative Outline

**Day 1: 1st hour:** Welcome/Overview of Class/Discuss principles with demos to explain ideas and concepts.

**2nd hour:** Mix Palette (Strings of colors).

**Lunch:** Brown Bag or ordered box lunch (see add-ons at registration) \*Limited restaurants available on Tuesdays.

**Entire Afternoon:** Paint in studio based on principles discussed in demo. Douglas moves through the group in a rotation, so everyone gets equal time.

**Day 2: 1st hour:** Overview/Review Specifics.

**All Day:** Paint in studio. Douglas moves through the group in a rotation, so everyone gets equal time.

**Lunch:** Brown Bag, eat out, or ordered box lunch (see add-ons at registration)

**Day 3: All of third day:** Paint in studio. Douglas moves through the group in a rotation, so everyone gets equal time.

**Lunch:** Brown Bag, eat out, or ordered box lunch (see add-ons at registration)

**Last hour:** In the last hour, after cleaning up, review of your 3 days of work ends the workshop on a very high note.
